CRIME PREVENTION COORDINATOR

The Coordinator is responsible for the development and implementation of innovative local crime prevention programming designated in particular to reduce the involvement of young people in criminal activities. Duties include: development of community based preventative programs; working with local/regional based police agencies; conducting workshops to educate youth and the public in making appropriate alternatives to drug and alcohol abuse; assist other groups wishing to establish similar programs; recruitment and training of volunteers; and submission of reports and proposals. Other related duties include being informed of current programs in different locales and identifying criminal activity trends.

Knowledge/experience with Blackfoot language and/or culture is a definite asset. Good interpersonal skills, communication skills and an ability to work as part of a professional community corrections team is required. Good writing skills are essential and computer literacy is also an advantage. Successful candidates must be able to attend training, a valid driver's license and a vehicle are required. Recruitment process includes interview screening, criminal record check and a written assignment. Salary commensurate to applicant's education and experience for the position.

Kainai Community Corrections Society addresses the needs of Native Offenders by providing cultural and community programs and services to adult and young offenders living on the Blood Reserve and vicinity within Southern Alberta. These programs focus on the community aspect of community corrections and crime prevention, utilizing local Elders as counselors to communicate relative values and instill a sense of pride.
