**FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION:**

The Rangeland Health Technician assists the Senior Resource Management Technician in providing the Blood Tribe Land Management Department with research related to native grassland health. Data collected will reflect applied scientific project outputs, advice on ecosystem management and species-at-risk issues, environmental perspectives and issues related to Blood Tribe lands. The incumbent deals specifically in ensuring activities impacting Blood Tribe Lands are in accordance with Tribal/Provincial/ and Federal Regulations. The incumbent accomplishes this by conducting fieldwork in order to collect baseline information and to develop monitoring programs where appropriate. The incumbent enters the information into the BTIGIS database, which is linked to other information pertaining to the Blood Tribe Lands.

**NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:**

1. Must possess knowledge of rangeland health and pasture management for proper management and monitoring of native grasslands.
2. Must be physically fit and have the ability to work outdoors for extended periods.
3. Must have a working knowledge of current computer hardware and software including word processing, spreadsheets, databases, web browsers, GIS and GPS.
4. Must have an interest in nature and an appreciation for all forms of life.
5. Must have initiative and openness to interpreting facts in different ways.
6. Must have strong communication skills, both written and oral.
7. An understanding of Blackfoot is an asset.

**NECESSARY TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:**

- Must possess a Grade Twelve education and a two-year post-secondary diploma in Environmental Science or related field with a minimum of two to three years work experience; or completed course work towards an Environmental Science, Pasture Management or related degree with a minimum of two to three years work experience.

- Must possess a valid Class 5 Driver's License.
